**Entry Fees**

Events 1 – 36 are: \$6.00 per dance (with local membership) or \$12.00 per dance without local membership.

Late Fee: (after Feb 28, 2015) \$10.00. **No entries accepted after March 2, 2015.**

Surcharges \$2.00 per dancer (SHD - \$1, SDCCS Provincial Surcharge - \$1)

**All dancers are required to show proof of local membership to receive the subsidized fee.**

Intermediate / Premier Workshop: \$20 if local association member, otherwise \$30

### **Competition & Workshop Information**

1. **SOBHD rules** govern the competition. Dancers will compete in their own age groups only. Proof of age must be shown if requested.
2. **SOBHD Card** must be shown. If not shown, \$5 fee is charged & prizes withheld until card is shown.
3. **Entry Fee:** Entry fee for all dances is either \$6 (subsidized) or \$12. Saskatchewan dancers must show a local association card to be eligible for the subsidized fee. Out of province dancers are automatically eligible for the subsidized fee with a local association card.
4. **Entries:** No refunds will be given.
  - Late Entries - entries after the closing date must include a \$10 late fee per dancer.
5. **Status Changes** - must be phoned or emailed to Don Morrison (306) 789-4576 or [dmorrison@sasktel.net](mailto:dmorrison@sasktel.net)
6. **Dancers** must be on hand to dance in numerical sequence, or forfeit right to dance in that event. Last to enter, first to dance. Classes to be divided at discretion of competition chair, depending on the entries received at closing.
7. **Awards:** Dancers must remain in full costume, including dance shoes, for presentation of awards.
  - To a minimum of half the number of dancers dancing, to a maximum of six placings. No trophy will be presented for Primary.
  - The SOBHD scoring system will be used for aggregate awards: 88, 56, 38, 25, 16, 10. No aggregate awards will be presented for Primary.
  - Premier 16 & Over prizes: 1st-\$25, 2nd-\$20, 3rd-\$15, 4th-\$10, 5th-\$10, 6th-\$10. These dancers may purchase medals for \$3/medal.
8. **Performance Pas de Basques** is for performance only. It is open to dancers under 7 years of age, who have not competed previously and are not competing in any of events 1 through 4. There is no charge for this event and no awards will be given.
9. **The decision of the judge is final.** Protests must be in writing and handed to the Competition Chairperson on the day of the competition, accompanied by a \$15 fee which will be refunded if sustained.
10. **Flash cameras are not allowed during competition**
11. **Workshop: Schedule will be posted at competition.** Dancers who are not participating in the competition will be called or emailed.
  - Beginner, & Novice – 1 hour. Intermediate & Premier - 1.5 to 2 hours. Classes may be adjusted based on class size.
  - Dancers to wear appropriate practice clothing, and bring your own water bottle. Please arrive ahead of schedule to do your own warm up.
  - Private lessons may be offered if time permits. Preference will be given to RHDA members.
12. The organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received.
13. The Competition chair reserves the right to cancel the competition if there are less than 60 entries
14. **Joanne Sinclair Memorial Trophy** is awarded to the highest placing 7 year old in the Beginner Class
15. **Danny Matheson Memorial Trophy** is awarded to the premier dancer of the day with the highest aggregate points over all dances. Age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of competition in order to be eligible for an overall trophy. As per SOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
