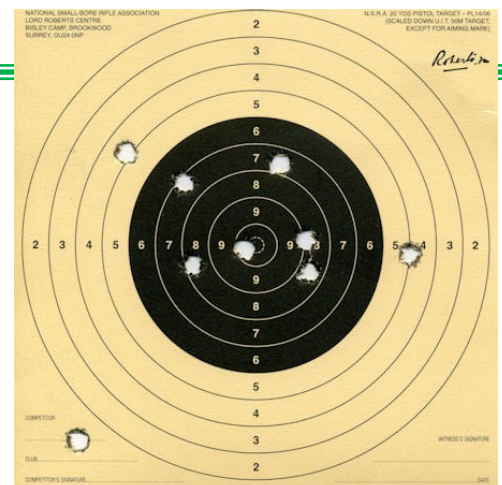

In addition to the club matches, members of the GPSA continue to raise funds for the New Building Fund by offering Firearm Safety classes, both Non-Restricted and Restricted, for people interested in applying for their Firearm Possession and Acquisition License (PAL). The instructors donate all their time, and all the course fees go towards the New Building Fund.

The course instructors advocate a hands-on approach to augment the Federal Firearm Safety Course material. Actually handling various types of firearms really brings home the practices of safe firearm handling to the students. Many students have commented that the hands-on experience really helps reinforce the course material because they actually get to handle various types of firearms.

In addition to the course fees paid by the students going to the New Building Fund, many of the students also end up purchasing RWF memberships in order to use the range facilities once they become firearm owners, making it a win-win situation for the RWF.

# Habitat Supper

Members at a recent meeting discussed the best season for the club to hold the annual Habitat Dinner and voted to move the fund raiser to spring. Rationale:

1. We believe that we can better avoid hunting season which has previously impacted both volunteers and attendees
2. Sponsors advise that they have budgeted monies for early in the year and this is apt to be used up by September/October, the traditional date of the dinner
3. Volunteers advise they are less busy with children's events in April than in October
4. Rider games are complete for the year so that attendees are not torn between the Rider game and the RWF event.
5. This year, the vendor gave away our calendar date
6. Hall rental groups advise that spring appears to be the better time for events

This decision was not taken lightly as there are benefits and drawbacks to any month or any season but spring appeared the best choice. Hopefully, this works well for our 25 – 30 dedicated volunteers who routinely help out with this event which allows us to support habitat and conservation.

1. A contribution was to made to the Sask Wildlife Federation Habitat Trust Fund and education fund
2. A contribution was made to the Region 4 purchase of two quarters of land to be held for habitat use
3. Investigations continue regarding installing a floating dock and bridge(s) at Condie for use by those school and outdoors groups who come to the site for education.

# Range Flags and Regulations

Under federal regulations governing shooting ranges it is required that a red flag be flown at the entrance of the property and at the firing line whenever the range is being used. As our ranges are usually unsupervised it is the member’s responsibility to ensure adherence to this regulation. In addition the ranges have been federally approved for specific calibers. Please use the appropriate range for the firearm you are shooting. Failure to comply with these laws could result in penalties up to and including closure of our ranges. Please remember to raise the flags before you start shooting and take them down when you are done. Now that the security gate is operating the signing of the range book is no longer required. If you are a member of an affiliated club, please respect their rules.

The RWF recreation site is private property and access is restricted to members, their guests and those in attendance for authorized functions. With the exception of RWF board sanctioned events, the ranges are always restricted to members with the proper range usage privileges. This is your club and as a member in good standing, you have the right to politely request the other users on the range to produce their membership cards. If an individual cannot produce the card then it is also within your rights to ask this person to leave and only return when a proper membership can be produced. Also, take a few minutes to look around the property and report anything that looks



## **R.W.F. Recreation Center Rules**

- Entry is restricted to members and guest accompanied by a member.
- Only currently paid-up members are permitted to use shooting facilities.
- Vehicles must stay on developed roads only.
- No wildlife of any kind may be shot at or molested within the property boundaries.
- As a guide, safe firearms handling practices as outlined in the Saskatchewan Firearms Safety Course must be adhered to and in the interest of personal safety. The use of hearing and shooting glasses is recommended.
- No persons appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs are permitted on the firing line.
- No loaded firearms shall be carried anywhere on the premises. Ranges are posted stating type of firearm permitted thereon. No exceptions will be permitted.
- Shooting at established targets only is permitted. No targets shall be set up on the range floor or dykes. NO GLASS objects are to be used under any circumstances.
- Shooters must not tie up firing points beyond reasonable time limits at times of heavy demand on facilities. Firearms must be open and untouched on benches while anyone is downrange.
- No firearms shall leave the firing line containing a live round. Upon completion of firing, shooters must remove all equipment such as scopes, targets spent cases etc. Immediately clearing firing line for others to use.
- In the event of firearm malfunction, all firing must cease until faulty firearm has been repaired or

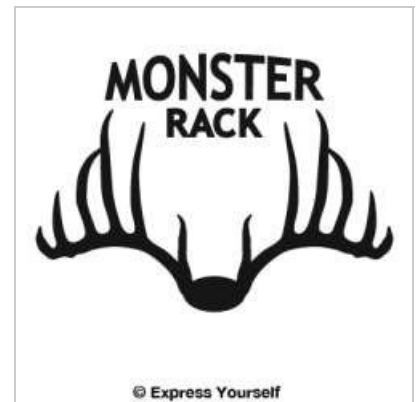
